About Public Comment at Corvallis Schools Foundation Meetings

Meetings of the Corvallis Schools Foundation Board Members are meetings of a public body held in public. All meetings, unless otherwise provided by law, are open to the public. Unless specifically called for that purpose, a school board meeting is not, however, a public hearing.

Each Board meeting includes a "Public Comment" section near the beginning of the agenda. At this time members of the audience will be invited to speak to any agenda item or on any public matter under the jurisdiction of the district that is not specifically listed on the agenda. However, under Montana law, comment cannot be allowed about individuals (employees, students, community members) who have not been notified that they will be the subject of discussion at a board meeting and who, therefore, have not had the opportunity to be present and waive their right to privacy. Montana law also restricts comment on contested cases, other adjudicative proceedings, or personnel matters.

If a subject that is not otherwise on the agenda is brought up during the public comment period, the trustees may not discuss or take any action on the issue and will restrict their role to listening until such time as the issue is placed on the agenda at a future board meeting. This is to protect the right of all members of the public to be notified through an agenda and have the opportunity to comment before board discussion and action take place. Members of the public who desire immediate response or action on an issue are advised to contact the superintendent at least five days prior to a school board meeting so that their issue can be dealt with administratively or placed on the agenda.

Members of the public who have not given input on an agenda item during the Public Comment period and wish to speak at the time the agenda item is discussed will be recognized. Recognition of members of the public, who have spoken to an agenda item during the Public Comment period, but wish to offer further input on an agenda item later in the meeting, is at the discretion of the board chair. The Board Chair may place reasonable time limits on any comments offered during the Public Comment period or during later discussion of agenda items.
